Questions and comments expressed by the community during the presentation – questions and comments were written down and are presented here as close to the individuals original wording as possible but may be paraphrased:

- That solar canopy is probably going to be vandalized and the solar panels stolen. What are you doing to combat this and what will happen when they're stolen?
 - We want to try to install them. The solar canopy will offset the energy consumption of the park and ABI is committed to the goal of environmental sustainability. If they are stolen, they will likely be replaced. If they are stolen multiple times, we will have to address that as it happens. The designers are looking to solutions for design that will discourage theft.
