


- Subarea Master Plans 1, 4, 8, & 10 conceptual phase is on display





Date	Forum	Purpose
August 2009	Citywide Conversation (11 <sup>th</sup> )	Community Education on Community Benefits (CB) & introduce/launch the development & decision-making process
October 2009	Study Group Mtgs – Round 1	Brief recap CB education & process; present existing input on principles to date to jumpstart the brainstorming & prioritization exercise for CB principles development
November 2009 - January 2010	ABI, TADAC, & Working Group preparation & planning meetings	Organize & process input for finalization of principles
January - March 2010	Small Group Stakeholder Engagement	Vet final draft of CB principles with stakeholders (TADAC CB Committee) including a developer focus group
Summer 2010	Study Group Mtgs – Round 2	Validate final principles w/community
Summer 2010	Citywide Briefing	Brief community on final outcomes of CB principle development process that informs CB policy to be approved by ABI/ADA & council
Fall 2010	ABI/ADA Board Mtgs & CD/HR Committee Mtg	City Council to approve principles & policy







## Subarea 10 – Maddox Park Existing Conditions















#### Historic Fourth Ward Park - Phase II




- Soil Remediation of Cox parcel well underway
