

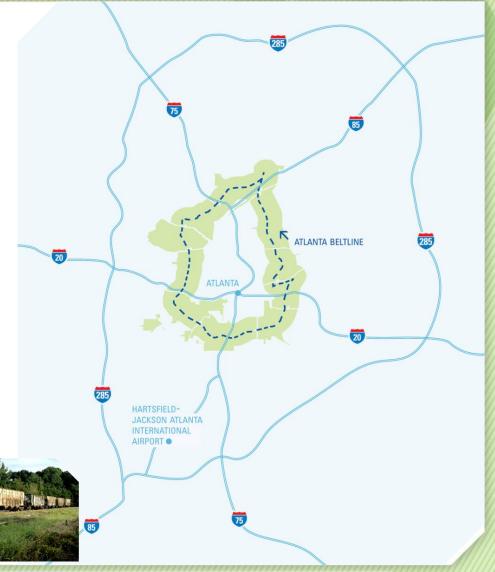

// Where is the Atlanta BeltLine?



- In the heart of the Atlanta region
- Connects many of Atlanta's cultural destination
- Connects four historic abandoned freight rail rights of way encircling the center of town
- Connects 45 neighborhoods
- 22% of City of Atlanta population lives in the planning area
- 19% of the City's land mass is inside the planning area

22 MILES of Transit & Transportation Infrastructure





46 MILES Streetscapes & **Complete Streets**

// ROI - Eastside Trail





- \$13 million post purchase project cost (design + construction) with \$5 million contribution from private donors
- Over \$750 million in new private development within half a mile of this segment of the Atlanta BeltLine



// Westside Trail



- 3 mile multi-use trail from Washington Park (Lena Street) to University Avenue
- \$43M project cost
- Under construction



// Federal Home Loan Bank of Atlanta Housing Initiative Program (HIP)



- Structured Partnership Program (set-aside)
- Major Components (all homeownership)
 - Downpayment Assistance
 - Owner Occupied Rehabilitation
 - Acquisition Rehabilitation or Redevelopment

Funding

- 2:1 ABI to FHLB commitment
- Min. of \$400K from ABI in year 1. Up to \$1M from FHLB in year 1.
- Anticipate multi-year partnership

Income Limits

- 80% of Area Median Income. \$51K for family of four, \$41K for family of two, \$36K for a family of 1.
- Represents families who would not be able to purchase a home in the City without this assistance

Geography

· Anywhere within Atlanta BeltLine Planning Area

Anticipated Outcomes

- 25 closings or more in year one. Growth in subsequent years.
- Program launched March 2nd



// HIP Downpayment Assistance

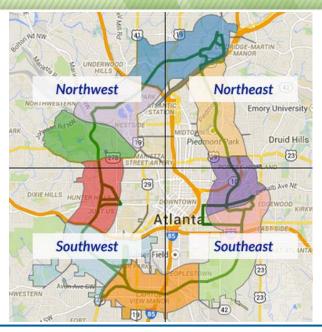


Provides 20% of the home purchase price via 2nd and 3rd silent mortgages

- Up to \$45,000
- No principal or interest payments during the life of the loan
- Loan repayment upon resale, refinancing, foreclosure, bankruptcy, or renting of the home
- Loans progressively forgiven after 5 years of home occupancy

Applicants must:

- Be pre approved by a participating lender
- Purchase a home in the Atlanta BeltLine Planning Area (within a half-mile of the BeltLine corridor)
- Provide at least \$1,000 of their own funds at closing
- Complete first-time homebuyer training
- Have a household income below 80% AMI



Income Eligibility

Households must earn under 80% of the Area Mean Income, which equates to:

1 Person Household // \$36,080

2 Person Household // \$41,280

3 Person Household // \$46,400

4 Person Household // \$51,520

5 Person Household // \$55,680

6 Person Household // \$59,840

7 Person Household // \$63,920

8 Person Household // \$68,080

// HIP Downpayment Assistance



Pre-application can be completed in three steps as follows

Get Pre-Qualified by a Lender

- Talk to one of them to get pre-qualified for a first mortgage

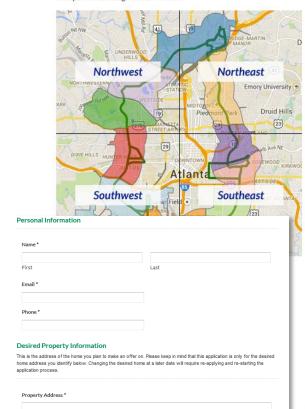
Submit a Pre-Application for Downpayment Assistance

 The information you provide on our online form will be carefully guarded and sent to Federal Home Loan Bank of Atlanta and Atlanta BeltLine, Inc.

Search by Area

We have set up a special home search just for this program. It is preset to display only homes for sale within the Atlanta BeltLine Planning Area. This includes condos, townhomes, and single-family homes. The maximum purchase price displayed is \$200,000; however, purchase prices will vary from person to person depending upon the pre-qualification you have from your lender.

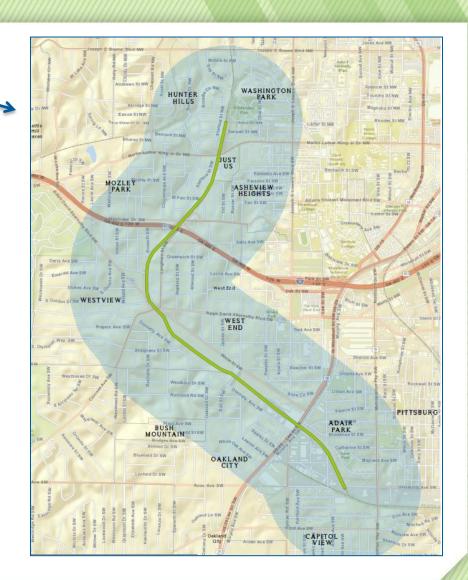

// HIP Owner Occupied Rehab



- Homes must be within ½ mile of the Atlanta
 BeltLine Westside Trail
- Up to \$25,000 in critical home repairs to keep homeowners safe, warm, and dry in the current residences
- Loans are in the form of 2nd and 3rd silent mortgages
- Prioritization given to properties adjacent to the Westside Trail
- Submit an application at www.atlantabeltlinehomes.com <u>before April 13</u>
 - ABI will contact you once application is received
- At the end of the application period, ABI will evaluate eligibility in priority order
 - We hope to fund 10 rehabilitation projects this calendar year



// HIP Owner Occupied Rehab



Applicants must:

- Own their home for more than 1 year
- Be current on taxes and mortgage payments
- Live within ½ mile to the Atlanta BeltLine Westside trail
- Request rehabilitation assistance that does not exceed \$25,000
- Take a Clearpoint homeownership education class prior to rehabilitations
- Must have a household income below 80% of AMI
