

# // Where is the Atlanta BeltLine?

- In the heart of the Atlanta region
- Connects many of Atlanta's cultural destinations
- Utilizes historic freight rail rights of way around the center of town



- Connects 45 neighborhoods
- 22% of City of Atlanta population lives in the Atlanta BeltLine planning area
- 19% of the City's land mass is inside the Atlanta BeltLine planning area
- 40% increase in Atlanta's parkland
- 6,500 acre TAD

- Atlanta BeltLine, Inc. to replace bridge
- Construction will begin in early 2013 and run through spring 2014



- Sept – Nov 2012
- Along 9 miles of the Corridor
- 76 exhibiting performing and visual artists



## Atlanta BeltLine Night at the Braves


- 200 fans attended 4<sup>th</sup> annual event



## Atlanta BeltLine Tours (Tours.BeltLine.org):


- Grant funding from the Arthur M. Blank Family Foundation
- 1,800 participants in 2012; nearly 14,000 since 2007





- **BeltLine.org: 88,700+ visits this quarter**
  - 64% increase in traffic over Q3 2011
- **Facebook: 11,300+ fans**
  - a 47% over Q3 2011
  - 1,430+ fans for Art on the Atlanta BeltLine fan page,
    - 44% increase over Q2 2012
  - 920+ fans for Atlanta BeltLine Running series page,
    - 23% increase over Q2 2012
- **Twitter: 6,640+ followers**
  - 11% increase over Q2 2012
- **eNews : 15,400+ recipients of email newsletters**
  - a 31 % increase over previous year: Q3 2011





## Addressing Social Impacts


- Atlanta Land Trust Collaborative continues to focus on creating permanently affordable housing around the Atlanta BeltLine
- Atlanta BeltLine Partnership is working with partners and pursuing funding to achieve health outcomes via the Atlanta BeltLine
- Atlanta BeltLine Partnership is pursuing funding with partners to create better employment pipelines to private sector jobs around the Atlanta BeltLine



## Atlanta BeltLine Partnership Capital Campaign

- \$38 million raised from 110+ donors
- \$35.1 million spent or committed to parks, trails, and Partnership programs
