### **What is the geography?**

- Lot of information available at the census tract level. Some at block group level
- Draw half mile band through census tracts. If more than 50% of census tract, include.

### **How many people are employable in BeltLine neighborhoods?**

- Longitudinal Household – Employment Dynamics (Mike for 26<sup>th</sup> will provide socio-economic profile for ½ mile and one mile)

### **What are the businesses/jobs around the Atlanta BeltLine?**

- Department of Labor list to ARC has type of business, number of employees. Available to share in aggregate. Messy. Business license
- Windshield survey. Dallas team. Using BeltLine volunteers or class at GSU.
- LE-HD: can tell you where people live and work (Mike will provide ½ mile and mile for 26<sup>th</sup>). Employment profile.
- Buxton – stadium neighborhood slide
- Grease trap permits from watershed identify restaurants
- Georgia Power – who has power.
- Info USA – goes through the phone book. ABI has access to it through Georgia Tech.
- NETS Data – good business starts and business deaths
- Business licenses
