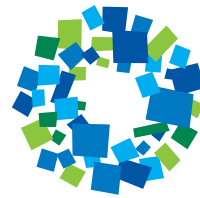

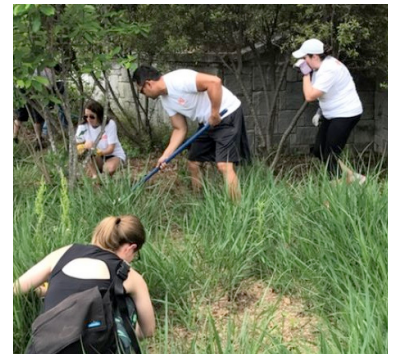
About Adopt the Atlanta BeltLine
