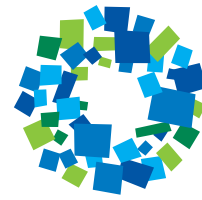

Formed in 2005, the **Atlanta BeltLine Partnership** (ABP)

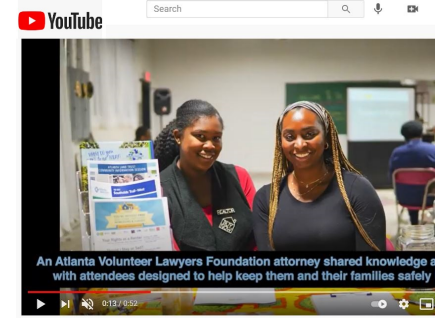

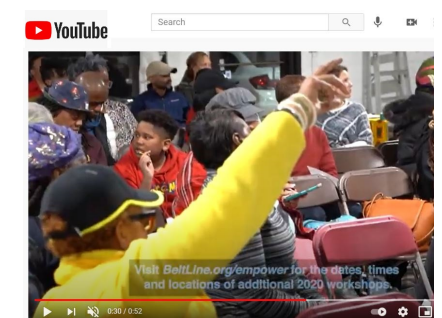
